As an End-of-Life Doula, I work with terminally ill people and their loved ones. One of my services includes talking about and implementing a Legacy Project. In case you are unfamiliar, that is something that can represent you after you die. Something tangible for those to hold or something to participate in or enjoy after you are gone. These projects can take various forms depending on the individual and their interests, values, and impact on others.

While you can start or complete a Legacy Project at any time, including after death, including the dying person in the creative process is a beautiful way to show them how much they are loved before they die.

## Legacy projects are important for several reasons:

**Honoring the Deceased:** They provide a tangible way to honor and remember the person who has died. By creating something in their memory, loved ones can pay tribute to their life and accomplishments.

- 36. Organize a charity event benefiting the deceased's favorite charity. Golf, baseball, football, art, crafting, or whatever they enjoyed in life.
- 37. Legacy Time Capsule Assemble a time capsule with meaningful items and letters.
- 38. DIY Memorial Garden Stones Decorate stones with messages and place them in a garden.
- 39. Legacy Cookbook Compile a cookbook with family recipes and memories.
- 40. Memory Lanterns Release Release lanterns with messages in honor of your loved one.
- 41. Customized Memorial Puzzle Pieces Create a puzzle where each piece represents a memory.
- 42. Digital Memorial Art Installation Design a digital art installation dedicated to their memory.
- 43. Memory Wall Collage Arrange photos and mementos in a visually appealing collage.

- 72. Virtual Memorial Book Club Read and discuss books that were significant to your loved one.
- 73. Legacy Video Game High Score Tournament Create or compete in a tournament to honor them.
- 74. Customized Memorial Jigsaw Puzzle Create a unique jigsaw puzzle featuring memories.
- 75. Virtual Memorial Paint and Sip Night Paint and share memories together online.

## BONUS idea!

Did your loved one wear glasses or reading glasses? You can make a fantastic ornament out of them! Simply paint the lenses (not the frames) some shade of white. Let dry and decorate the pair as a snowman (top lens: eyes, nose, mouth; bottom lens: buttons). Make a scarf out of a piece of your favorite fabric by wrapping it on the nose bridge (between the two lenses) and make a knot to secure it. Hang on the tree or wherever you hang your ornaments.

You could also purchase a small tree to use as a memorial tree at Christmas. Those who wish to participate can make an ornament for the tree yearly in memory of a loved one.
